

DISPLAY VEHICLE REPORTING INFORMATION

Deadline: December 5, 2025

If you will be utilizing vehicles for display purposes in your booth, you must file a Display Vehicle Reporting Form by **December 5**, **2025**.

Companies using vehicles in displays must have a minimum of 200 sq. ft. per vehicle.

Example: One vehicle = 200 sq. ft.

Two vehicles = 400 sq. ft. Three vehicles = 600 sq. ft.

NADA requires prior notification of all vehicles that will be on display in the facility. If you do not report displayed vehicles to NADA Show Management, we will not approve them for move-in.

Las Vegas Convention Center Vehicle Regulations

Note: Any autos, trucks, motorcycles, boats, other motorized vehicles, or other flammable fueled engines must conform to the following requirements:

- 1. Fuel tank openings shall be locked or sealed in an approved manner to prevent escape of vapors; fuel is limited to one-quarter its tank or five gallons of fuel, whichever is less.
- 2. At least one battery cable shall be removed from the batteries used to start the vehicle engine, and the disconnected battery cable shall then be taped. Batteries required to demonstrate auxiliary equipment shall be permitted to be kept in service.
- 3. Auxiliary batteries not connected to engine starting system may be left connected.
- 4. Electric and hybrid vehicles shall have their operating batteries disconnected whenever possible.
- 5. External chargers or batteries are recommended for demonstration purposes.
- 6. Battery charging is not permitted in the exhibit hall, at any time.
- 7. Combustible/flammable materials must not be stored beneath display vehicles.
- 8. Fueling or de-fueling of vehicles is prohibited.
- 9. Vehicles shall not be moved during expo hours.
- 10. 36 inches of clear access or aisles must be maintained around the vehicle.

Please note: There will be a spotting fee of \$360.75 for move-in and move-out of all display vehicles.
