

Connected Vehicle Security Act ([H.R. 8730](#)/[S. 4429](#)) Summary

CVSA as passed the Senate Commerce Committee would ban the import, sale, manufacture, and resale of connected vehicles (15% ownership limit), software (25% ownership limit), and hardware (25% ownership limit) linked to foreign adversaries like China. The bans take effect on January 1, 2027 for connected vehicles, MY2027 for software, and January 1, 2030 for hardware.

Affected OEMs currently selling in the U.S. (like Mercedes and Volvo) can apply for an authorization that would allow them to continue to import, manufacture, sell or resell connected vehicles, hardware, or software that would otherwise be prohibited by the bill. Any authorizations that were issued prior to 2030 would sunset by 2030. Congress can enact a joint resolution of disapproval with respect to the authorization.
